We are looking for volunteers to staff our temporary space. Specifically, we need a volunteer office coordinator and office volunteers and anyone who wants to help set up this process. We have lots of files to make sense of, a telephone thatwill start ringing soon (we hope!) mailing to be done and some typing. We are thinking of having the space open five hours a day plus one evening/saturday. Typing skills are not necessary for all volunteers to have, but we will need some good typists. Volunteers will be paid bus fare or the same amount toward parking. Interest in and enthusiasm about the Womens Building, plus comfort talking to newcomers are the main qualifications we are looking for. We will also offer a short workshop for volunteers to get them started. Anyone wanting to be involved with this program is urged to call Lyn. Cockburn, Nancy McMurchy, Bet McMurchy or Susan Moger (see phone numbers this issue) as soon as possible. We want to have office volunteers and office coordinator set up by November 16th. P.S. We are wanting to get the office volunteers set-up because we hope to have a <u>fundraiser</u> working within the next two months. After checking with appropriate people, it was decided at the September working members meeting: that the fundraiser would be paid a straight commission plus operating costs, that we would be open to having the job shared ( two women each working part - time) and that our goal is to buy a house costing \$250,000 maximum. We are currently contacting women who have expressed interest in doing the job and will advertise within the next month if we have not found the right woman (women). Anyone interested in this challenging job is asked to call Bet McMurchy 598-7535, as soon as possible. We have decided on fees to be charged if any of you are interested in <u>renting our space</u> for a workshop, lecture or course. The fee is \$5.00 per hour. The space can comfortably accomodate ten to fifteen people. For a lecture, given seating would be pre-arranged, 30-35 people would probably be the maximum. Jean Mosely is arranging booking. We are particularly interested in having the space used evenings and weekends. Do call Jean 385-0982. Our price is competitive and it is a wonderful way to support the Womens Building!

We still <u>need some basic furnishings</u> for the space. Floor pillows, folding/stacking chairs, floor lamps, shelving of any kind, file cabinets, typewriters, desks and a teapot are high priority items. Many thanks to those of you who have already donated or loaned additional items that we needed.
