00:00:18 - 00:00:31	MGH & TPH & AEH walking in ryokan (inn) garden to lake with oars
00:00:31 - 00:01:33	MGH & TPH & AEH on dock with rowboat, getting in & setting off w. TPH rowing and later all of them coming ashore
00:01:33 - 00:02:09	GIH & MGH & TPH setting off riding bikes along forest road
00:02:09 - 00:02:45	Panning view of hills/mtns leading to GIH & kids at swimming pool edge. GIH wrestling with TPH trying to throw him into the water. Both fall in.
00:02:45 - 00:03:16	TPH getting out of pool while AEH is trying to climb down ladder. TPH runs off away from camera. GIH in water, boys dive in from diving board
00:03:16 - 00:04:12	Boys standing at pool's edge then joining GIH & AEH in pool – all swim together
00:04:12 - 00:04:38	Boys diving off of diving board & getting out again
00:04:38 - 00:04:53	GIH & AEH (dressed nicely) sitting on bench boys come and join them
00:04:53 - 00:05:09	TPH & MGH diving off of diving board - again
00:05:09 - 00:05:22	MGH collecting his shoes while GIH & AEH talk to TPH (not seen)
00:05:22 - 00:05:49	TPH & AEH in one boat w. MGH & servant in another releasing model boat
00:05:49 - 00:06:15	Both row boats circling model boat
00:06:15 - 00:06:23	Servant walking back to inn
00:06:23 - 00:06:49	GIH w. children at picnic table
00:06:49 - 00:07:08	GIH w. children getting ready & walking away from hilltop rest-place
00:07:08 - 00:07:59	Lakeside scene with Japanese man bringing rowboat for GIH, boys & another lady to get into – then them rowing around the lake
00:08:00 - 00:08:18	Japanese couple (w. 4 daughters) watching as GIH & group come ashore.
00:08:18 - 00:08:20	Village street scene w. GIH & boys & omnibus going by

00:09:31 - 00:09:39	Japanese lady (teacher?) standing next to 7 children that are crouching writing on paper (damaged film)
00:09:39 - 00:10:06	GIH, MGH & TPH in front of shop door holding and practicing shooting large Japanese bows (w arrows) (damaged film)
00:10:06 - 00:10:19	Looking down funicular tracks as other car comes up track (damaged film)

00:10:23 - 00:10:24	MGH & TPH standing at edge of stream with sticks (damaged film)
00:10:24 - 00:10:38	GIH sitting on bench & children stream side. Boys throwing rocks into stream, AEH playing crouching on ground. In background bridge and directly behind GIH walkway tunnel entrance/exit (damaged film)
00:10:38 - 00:10:49	Boys close-up from behind throwing rocks in stream. In the background the side of a large building, perhaps a hotel. (damaged film)
00:10:49 - 00:11:16	MGH & TPH stand at edge of stream throwing more rocks with panning view of surrounding area. Waterfall in background (damaged film)
00:11:16 - 00:11:36	GIH w. TPH & AEH then MGH further downstream closer to waterfall
00:11:36 - 00:11:51	Looking up hill then panning down along waterfall/stream path (damaged film)
00:11:51 - 00:12:08	Fujiya Hotel (Hakone) swimming pool slide w. TPH splashing down
