Working from $\Im - 5$ p.m. in all types of weather and mud with only a half hour break for lunch, they receive pay from .90/hr. to a maximum of \$1.10/hr. for women, a maximum of \$1.35/hr. for men.Help boycott this year's harvest. Your help is needed. If you are willing to help in any way, please phone 477-3549.
