00:12:30 – 00:12:39	Amalienburg Hunting Lodge (1734-39) designed by Johann Baptist Zimmermann (1680-1758) & Joachim Dietrich (1690–1753)

00:12:45 – 00:12:53	Temple of Apollo/Apollotempel design by Leo v. Klenze constructed by Carl Mühlthaler 1862–65 on shore of Badener Lake/See.
00:12:53 – 00:12:59	View from Badenburg (Bathing Pavillion) terrace of lawn bordered by forest with lion sculpture at left in foreground. Badenburg (1719–1721) was designed and built by Joseph Effner.
