Eco-shops

There are not a lot of shops in Copenhagen that specialize in ecological products. If you want pure organic fabrics and clothes, there are two shops in Copenhagen - MacGrails on Gamle Torv and Flint's on Pilestræde. MacGrails is the size of a small department store. Here you'll find three levels with a very large selection (not everything is ecological). At Flint's you can shop or check out the exhibition. Flint's also has an Internet service (in the shop or your own home) where you can order ecological products from around the world. Here you'll find Denmark's largest selection of organic fabrics. If you're looking for more sophisticated shops look into Ordning & Reda på Købmagergade and Bodum on the main walking street. Here you'll find some excellent and exciting paper products, some of which are made from recycled materials.

Restaurants

Today there are many restaurants that serve organically grown vegetables, meat from animals that are raised on organic farms, organic wine, etc. The menus do not always offer many choices, but remember there is not all that much organic farming going on here in Denmark or in the rest of the world. If you decide to try one of the restaurants listed here, make sure you request organic food - restaurants will be pressured into serving more organic food if people make a point of asking for them, this will in turn lead to a higher supply and demand and will encourage more farmers to switch to organic farming - so ask away. If you want a total organic food experience - expertly prepared - then check out the "eco-queen", Camilla Plum's restaurant, Cap Horn, in Nyhavn.

Biking in Copenhagen

Compared to other big cities, Copenhagen is an exceptional city for bikers. The city makes a major effort to make life easy for bikers. WATCH OUT when biking through the city hall square. Now that the square has been renovated, there are several biking death traps. Take extra care crossing the square to the street called Vestergade. We have not put any bike paths on the map because the city of Copenhagen has already published a bike path map that can be picked up at the information stand at the city hall square or by contacting Maiken König at 3366 2656. The map shows all the bike paths in the Greater Copenhagen area.

Mobile bike repairs

When you're standing there with a flat tire, broken spoke or whatever, it's nice to know you can call Cykelmobilen. They're quick to come and repair a flat or make small repairs (if there's time). There are other places that fix bikes and we list some addresses and telephone numbers on this map. The city bike map has even more.

Bike rentals

You can rent bikes several places throughout the city. The addresses can be found on this map.

Bike messenger services

To help keep the level of noise and smog low in the city, it's a good idea to use bike messengers. This is a good service for delivering letters, small packages, etc. around town. Copenhagen's first and biggest bike service is called de Grønne Bude. (#96)

City Bikes

City bikes is probably one of the most ambitious alternative transportation projects around. Anyone can use the specially designed bikes found at over 100 locations around the inner city. TAKE CARE OF THEM!

Bike sightseeing

City Safari is an alternative guide bureau where tourists bike around the city with an experienced guide. City Safari has five standard tours, special tours can be arranged for individuals, groups and school classes.

Internet and Information

Technology plus Ecology

It is now possible to use the Internet for all kinds of things. Even though Internet can't save the world, it can make life easier for lots of people. Internet is part of the foundation of what is called Information Technology (IT). With IT it is possible to cut back on the use of resources. Printed information, video, sound and much more can be put on the Net. This will save lots of paper, printing supplies, tape, etc. This map will be made available on the Net as soon as possible. The Internet and IT will offer many more possibilities in the future. Used in the right way, this will make our daily lives more fun and more efficient. Already now it is possible to make visual connections via the Net or via visual telephones. In this way it is possible to have meetings with people in other countries or cities with little physical effort. This means a reduction in fuel for transportation. It may sound like something out of a science fiction movie, but in Denmark it is already possible to have a sneak peek at the future and what IT has to offer - a public place called Mind Ship. There is also a restaurant at Mind Ship run by Henrik Boserup who uses organic foodstuffs as much as possible. The first exhibition - Brain Opera - opens September 13, 1996. The electronic café called the Networkshop (Netværkstedet) is expected to open in the fall of 1996. On the Internet you can find a wealth of information about the environment, recycling, etc. If you don't have access to the Net you can log on at many libraries. In the next column you will find some important addresses.

In Denmark organic means...

Farms and businesses with state-approved organic licensing are subject to inspection at least once a year. Farming products and foodstuffs that abide by the laws listed below receive the organic stamp of approval. These laws also apply to imported products:

1. Danish sanctions
2. European Community sanctions
3. International sanctions (IFOAM)

The organic stamp of approval shows that the Danish authorities were responsible at the last checkpoint. The term "organic farming" means that no artificial fertilization methods or chemical sprays have been used throughout the entire process. This farming protects the food, the surrounding nature and the water supply from contamination. Without artificial fertilization, the growing cycle is slower; the end result is a high quality, better-tasting product. Organic milk is not homogenized. Organic cheese and organic meat is without nitrates. Organically raised animals receive no preventive medicine in their diets, which is at least 85% organic as well. During the summer the animals are allowed to graze and in the winter they are able to get exercise.

Only 16% of additives that are internationally approved are allowed in organic foodstuffs. Bacteria and yeast agents must not be genetically modified. In order to be classified as organic, pre-packaged foodstuffs must be made up of no more than 5% non-organic ingredients.

We hope as many as possible will use the map, both the one on paper and the one on the Net.

Recycling & Sensible Use of Resources

We talk a lot about ecology but it is not only a question of growing and eating organic foodstuffs, we also have to think about conserving all other resources. We can do this in many ways. For example, we can recycle and reuse products and just about any materials. It is important to reuse materials that are made from the so-called non-renewable resources (oil and coal). It is important that all plastic and synthetic products, whenever humanly possible, are collected and recycled or reused in their original form or transformed into another form with as little use of other resources and energy as possible. An example of reuse is using packaging materials for something else. But plastic accounts for only 3% of our total oil consumption, therefore it is also important to conserve other things for example, oil used in warming our homes, transportation and our use of metal products, to name just a few.

There are many ways to sensibly use resources. For example you can trade products (i.e. clothes), you can begin using electronic mail instead of letters and telefaxes (of course we need to keep our penmanship up to par so we write personal letters with pen and ink on beautiful paper made from hemp or recycled paper) - there are thousands of ways to conserve our resources and at the same time live well.

Copenhagen collects environmentally-dangerous trash with the Environmental Truck (Miljøbilen) - everything from nail polish remover to weedkillers and old paint can be deposited here. If you want to what you can do, there are piles and piles of books and informative material that you can either buy or borrow. The Green Consumer Guide, published some time ago, is still accurate. You can also check out what is available at the Environmental Ministry.

Gardens

For some time now, Copenhagen has been trying to substitute the many chemicals used in their gardens, for example to destroy weeds, with more environmentally-friendly methods. Now some of the weeds are burned away. Unfortunately, unlike Oslo where the university park is run completely with ecological principals, there are still no completely ecological parks in Copenhagen.

The ecological city garden

This garden, on Guldbergsgade, is run by the "Ecological Initiators" and definitely worth the visit. The garden was built in one night and features several exciting activities. Another great project from the Ecological Initiators.

Christiania

On it's way to becoming a new alternative ecological-city experiment. At any rate there are lots of new things happening here. Some of the ecological activities are:

- rain water collection
- runoff water cleansing system
- composting
- trash separating

The latest news at Christiania is the establishing of a perma-culture group that is in the process of building a demonstration garden intended to be a part of the forest of the future. If you want to see some of the ecological activities at Christiania then contact Det Grønne Rum (The Green Room) at Christiania on Langgaden from 12-16:00 daily. There is no telephone at the present time.

The Garden at Enghave Plads

This is a small ecological garden run by several residents from the west side of Copenhagen (Vesterbro). Several types of vegetables and flowers are grown here.

Tivoli

Experimenting with homeopathic agents instead of chemicals in the Tivoli lakes is a new approach at Tivoli. Carp, working along with the homeopathic agents are used to keep the water clean. For the most part, no chemicals are used in Tivoli to control weeds. Burning is used whenever possible. Tivoli recycles all their left-over food, for example as pig feed. All paper, plastic, glass, etc. is recycled as well. In a nutshell, Tivoli is also thinking green. We will encourage them to use organic flowers and plants, perhaps the first amusement park in the world to do so. Without a doubt that would make Tivoli an even nicer place to visit.

(Green Information)

This is an impartial information agency funded by the Green Fund (Grøn Fond). It is possible here to receive information related to living in a more environmentally-friendly way. Be aware that this is an independent organization that is not subject to any checks from other organizations and therefore their facts could be incomplete.

Økologiske Igangsættere (Ecological Initiators)

This is an organization that works on a "professional" grass roots level to set into motion untraditional and original projects. The EI was involved in the city garden on Guldbergsgade as well as the Ecological Café on Griffenfeldtsgade. EI helps people, especially the young, to receive a new type of education working with some form of environmental issues where tolerance and commitment play major roles. Anything can happen here. Anyone wanting to initiate some sort of project can show up at one of EI's open meetings held every Friday at 13:00 at Ravnsborggade 18 (beginning in mid-August). Some of the new projects EI is working on at the moment are:

- an ecological garden house on Amager
- SLEEP-IN-GREEN (hostel) where everything is as ecological as possible. The hostel will sleep approximately 80.
